

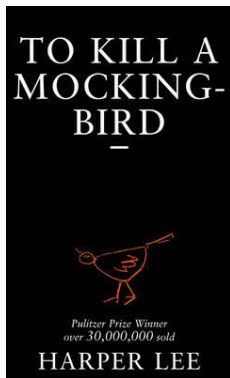

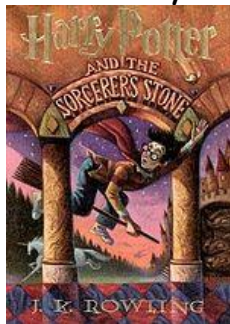
1. Of Mice and Men by John Steinbeck (6th last year)



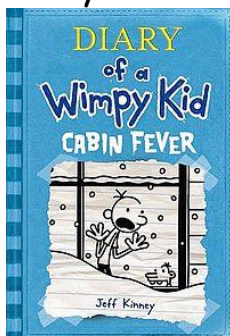
